For April 4-10, 2025



Bible Promises to Claim as You Pray:

"Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened" (Matt. 7:7-8).

"Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full" (John 16:24).

Prayer Focus for Week 2:

1. **READY:** Pray for a deeper heart desire and hunger for Jesus, for His Word, and to be ready to meet Him when He returns. (Claim Jeremiah 24:7.)
2. **SEARCH:** Pray that God would search your heart and reveal anything that might hinder your heavenward journey. Then confess and repent of any spiritual compromises that He brings to your mind. (Claim Psalm 139:23-24, 1 John 1:9.)
3. **PREPARE:** Pray that God would reveal His great love to you and prepare your heart for what He's about to do in your life during this 100 days of prayer. (Claim Romans 5:8, Psalm 10:17.)
4. **ACT:** Pray that God would help you slow down and re-prioritize your daily life so that you can find unrushed time with Him in His Word and in prayer. (Claim Matthew 6:33, Jeremiah 15:16.)
5. **REBUILD:** Pray that God would help you, your family members, your friends, and your church repair any broken down altars of worship or build stronger the altars of worship you have. (Claim 1 Kings 18:30, Psalm 95:6.)
6. **FOCUS:** Pray that God would forgive us as a church family for being distracted by our digital devices, our worldly pursuits, our idle chatter, our gossip and fault-finding, rather than keeping our focus on the one true thing that matters—to abide in Jesus' presence, and to prepare others for His soon return. (Claim Psalm 27:4, Psalm 16:11.)
7. **KEEP ASKING:** Pray that the Holy Spirit would be poured out in such rich measure on our church and the upcoming General Conference Session in St. Louis that it would be evident to all watching that Jesus is alive and coming soon! (Claim Luke 11:13.)

Prayer Focus for Week 2:

1. **PRAISE:** Pray that God would enrich your personal time with Him, and that He would put fresh praises in your heart and on your lips daily. (Claim Psalm 34:1)
2. **BUILD:** Pray that God would help you build others up and not tear them down by your words or actions. (Claim Ephesians 4:29-30, Ezekiel 36:26)
3. **YIELD:** Pray that your life and tongue would yield the sweet Fruit of the Spirit, not the bitter fruit of darkness. (Claim James 3:8-9, Galatians 5:22-23)
4. **PRIORITIZE:** Pray that daily unrushed worship would become a top life priority, that you and your family cannot live without. (Claim Deuteronomy 30:6, Psalm 29:2)
5. **WORSHIP:** Pray that God would restore and strengthen your personal and/or family altar of worship. Pray that God would help you worship with friends and family this week in a special way. (Claim Hebrews 10:25, Psalm 9:1)
6. **REVIVAL:** Pray that it won't be just business as usual at this coming GC session July 3-12, but a time of deep *spiritual revival* that will refresh the hearts of all in attendance. (Claim 2 Chronicles 7:14, Psalm 85:6)
7. **I WILL GO:** Pray that church members around the world will embrace the theme, "Jesus is Coming, I WILL GO!" And that all will be inspired with a heart for God's mission – to share the Three Angels' messages with a dying world. (Claim Isaiah 6:8, Revelation 14:6-7)

Prayer Focus for Week 3:

1. **HUMBLE:** Pray that God would strengthen us as a church family to humble ourselves as little children at the foot of the cross, to put away our quarrels, our grievances, to press together, and to prepare our hearts for Jesus' soon coming. (Claim Isaiah 57:15)
2. **DISCIPLES:** Pray that we would be true disciples of Jesus—in our home, in our workplace, in our school, in our business, and in private where no one sees but God. (Claim Romans 2:28-29, 1 Samuel 16:7)
3. **WORSHIP:** Pray that no distractions would keep us from daily worship and that we would live at the altar, both individually and as families, with all our heart and soul. (Claim 1 Chronicles 16:29)
4. **WITNESS:** Pray that the General Conference session theme, "Jesus is coming, I WILL GO" will be acted upon with urgency by every believer around the world, starting with ourselves. (Claim Isaiah 6:8, Isaiah 43:10)
5. **DEEPER:** Pray that each delegate and attendee at the General Conference session will experience a renewal of their "first love experience" with Jesus once again and be forever changed. (Claim Revelation 2:4, Mark 12:30)
6. **HONOR:** Pray for the logistical details and planning that is going on right now behind the scenes, for General Conference session. Pray that everything will fall into place for the glory and honor of God. (Claim Matthew 7:7-8, 1 Corinthians 10:31)
7. **OUTPOURING:** Pray that these upcoming General Conference meetings will be a turning point in our church history, that will help usher in the Latter Rain. (Claim Luke 11:13, Acts 1:8)

Prayer Focus for Week 4

1. **COME:** Pray that God would help you come to Him just as you are every day. But also pray that you would not remain as you are, but that He would change you from the inside out. (Claim Ezekiel 36:26, 2 Corinthians 5:17)
2. **SHARE:** Pray that you could have an opportunity to share the sweet assurance of salvation with another. (Claim 1 Peter 3:15)
3. **ABIDE:** Pray that Jesus would abide in you, and you would abide in Him through the power of the Holy Spirit. (Claim Ephesians 2:22)
4. **LOVE:** Pray for your unsaved loved ones or family members to catch a glimpse of the incredible love of Jesus. (Claim Romans 5:8)
5. **WORSHIP:** Pray that these Back to the Altar principles would become a part of your daily life, and that you would learn to live at the altar. (Claim Ps. 27:4)
6. **RECONCILE:** Pray that "What Might Have Been" in 1901 would happen in 2025 and that there would be confessions, humbling of heart, reconciliations, selfless service, and renewed focus on mission, for all in attendance at the General Conference session. (Claim 2 Chronicles 7:14, Psalm 85:6)
7. **FILL:** Pray that God will fill the St. Louis Stadium (the building where the General Conference meetings will take place) with His presence and that as soon as people walk into the stadium, they will sense the power of the Holy Spirit. (Claim Isaiah 65:24)

Prayer Focus for Week 4

1. **AWAKE:** Pray that honoring Jesus as Lord would become a living reality for your life. Pray that Jesus would wake you up each morning to have unrushed time with Him in His Word and in prayer. (Claim Isaiah 50:4)
2. **SURRENDER:** Pray the following prayer of surrender as you start the Sabbath: "Dear Jesus, I give You all that I am. I give You all that have. I give You my attitude and my electronics." Live this prayer of surrender daily! (Claim Philippians 2:9-11)
3. **ABIDE:** Pray to abide in Jesus each and every day by immersing yourself in the living Word. Rather than trying to produce the fruit of the Spirit, pray that the Prince of Peace, through the power of the Holy Spirit, would abide in you. (Claim John 15:5)
4. **BE IN AWE:** Pray that God would help you be in complete AWE of Him, His Word, and His mighty power as you go through this week. Pray that you would have no spirit of awe for the "Ahabs" the enemy might bring across your path. (Claim Romans 8:31)
5. **EXPERIENCE:** Pray that we would, in the prayer room at GC session, have an "Upper Room experience" as the disciples had at Pentecost. Pray that all pride and things of self would be put away as we seek unity in Christ. (Claim Acts 2:1-2)
6. **HONOR:** Pray that every conversation, every message, every concert, every song, every worship service, every business meeting, every decision made during the General Conference session, would be for the glory and honor of God. (Claim Psalm 115:1)
7. **STAND:** Pray that we, individually and collectively as a church, would stand for Bible truth and honor God, no matter the cost. (Claim 1 Corinthians 16:13)

Prayer Focus for Week 6

2. **REMEMBER:** Pray that this would be a high Sabbath as we come back to the altar, remembering that Jesus is our perfect Substitute and Surety. Pray that we can understand and share the message of righteousness by faith. (Claim Heb. 10:14)
3. **PLEAD:** Pray for God's will to be accomplished in who should lead our church in the next five years. Pray that we would not lean on human wisdom as we make leadership choices, but that we would plead for God's wisdom, for "man looks on the outward appearance, but God looks on the heart." (Claim James 1:5)
4. **DISCOVER:** Pray for the Holy Spirit to be our heavenly guide as we daily seek to discover fresh pictures of Jesus in the Word and in prayer. (Claim 1 Cor. 2:12-13)
5. **FOCUS:** Pray for a renewed heart for service and mission, no matter your sphere of influence or responsibilities. God has a place of service for each one of His children! (Claim Matt. 6:33) May the theme, "Jesus is coming soon, I will Go!" be our focus.
6. **SEARCH:** Pray for a renewed interest in the books of Daniel and Revelation as God's people search for hidden treasure. Jesus is our Treasure, and He's coming soon! (Claim Psalm 119:162 and Luke 24:27)
7. **REFRESH:** Pray that God's people would have boldness as they pray the promises of God's Word. God's Word does not return to Him void. (Claim 2 Peter 2:4 and Isa. 55:11)

Prayer Focus for Week 7

5. **GROW:** Dear Jesus, grow us as individuals, families, and churches. Refine our characters and purge away the chaff of sin and spiritual compromise from our hearts. Teach us how to build strong our altars of worship. (Claim John 4:24)
6. **EMBRACE:** Dear Heavenly Father, help us to embrace the call, I WILL GO. Give us courage to share with all we meet the Hope found in Your Word. (Claim John 17:3)
7. **DARE:** Dear Jesus, we ask for big things at the upcoming General Conference session. We are asking for an outpouring of Your Holy Spirit. We will not let go. We dare to ask for more. (Claim Jer. 33:3)

Prayer Focus for Week 8

4. **Stop** me, Lord, when I begin to drift from You. Interrupt my scrolling, silence the noise, and pull me back into Your stillness. When I'm tempted to numb or escape, remind me that You are my refuge. (Claim Psalm 119:37; Hebrews 12:1)
5. **Revise** my daily rhythm, Lord. Teach me to structure my life around Your voice, not notifications. Help me make wise changes to how I spend my time so I can hear You clearly and walk with You fully. (Claim Ephesians 5:15-16; Proverbs 3:6)
6. **Help** me, God, to focus when my mind wanders and my heart grows restless. Strengthen my discipline to seek You first. I cannot do this without Your Spirit guiding me and steadying my steps. (Claim Psalm 12:1-2; James 4:8)
7. **Breathe** on me Your Holy Spirit, Lord. Prepare me and prepare my brothers and sisters for Your soon coming. Bring us to life through the power of Your Word and prepare us as a church to meet You in the clouds of glory. (Claim Ezekiel 37:4-5)
