Just eight days later, her medical report came back, and the cancer was no longer visible. Sukhman immediately shared this news with Kuldeep, who encouraged her and her family through the Word of God and reminded them not to worry, for the Lord is with them.

Sukhman returned to the doctor, who also gave her family hope and prescribed some medication.

Pastor Kuldeep prayed again for Sukhman in the name of Jesus Christ. She thanked the Lord with all her heart—because within just 15 days, her follow-up report came back completely normal. The cancer was gone.

Sukhman shared, "From that day forward, I surrendered my heart to the Lord Jesus Christ. I accepted Him as my Savior and began walking in faith. Today, my entire family rejoices in the grace of God. We are transformed, filled with peace and joy."
